



The Roots of Reading program is offered in partnership with the Brampton Library and focuses on the six important literacy skills for children to develop reading and writing readiness.</p> <p align="center">Hour Together (Parents & caregivers with children up to six years) Time together for parents and caregivers to connect with each other, participate in activities and discuss a variety of topics. <i>Childminding is provided and spaces are limited.</i></p> <p align="center">Kindergarten Readiness * (three to six years) A hands-on 9 week school readiness program that will introduce your child to a variety of general knowledge topics. Activities will focus on language, literacy, numeracy and writing readiness.</p> <p align="center">Discovering Together (Newborn to six years) Learning through discovery about cause and effect relations, This program will focus on building, creating mini projects, science and math concepts.</p> <p align="center">Cook and Learn (Newborn to six years) Measure, mix, observe and taste yummy snacks. Children and parents are involved in making simple nutritious snacks and healthy meal planning. This program makes trying new foods fun!</p> <p align="center">Active Play and Games (Newborn to six years) Get moving during the winter months with a variety of active play activities that promote gross motor development and group games.
