

## Tips for Speech Therapy Homework

- Encourage and praise your child's communication attempts
- Set a good example for your child. Speak clearly and repeat if necessary
- Give your child enough time to respond
- Give your child accurate and positive feedback, (Avoid saying 'that's wrong' or 'no')

### Trying saying things like:

- "I like the way you said that word!"
- "That was a good 'f' sound!"
- "Try again, like this .....(you pronounce the sound again)"
- "Good try but not quite right"
- You can repeat the word with an emphasis on the sound and have the child repeat after you. You can give the child a choice, for example, "Is it a tink or a sink?"

### If your child is getting frustrated you can:

- Keep the rule of the activities as simple as possible
- Switch to a different activity
- It is acceptable to end a session early
- Try again later or on another day
